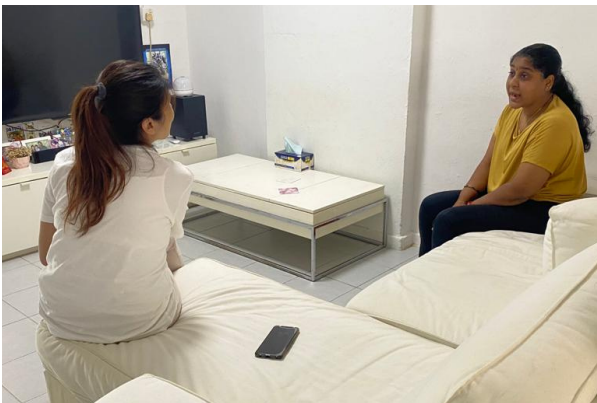
## ABOUT SSVP LTD.
